## Spiritual Discipline Lesson 4 Use your Passcode! "Prayer releases the Treasures of Heaven"

"Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples," (Luke 11:1)

In order to protect crooks from stealing money from your personal account, banks provide you with a passcode. It does not matter how much you have in your account, without the proper passcode, the funds will not be release.


Just like there is a passcode that is needed to release earthly treasure, God has given believers a passcode to release heavens treasures. The passcode is called prayer. In order to activate the passcode you must you it. The Apostle James reminds us that untold treasure is not being redrawn from heavens bank account. He says, "You have not because you ask not, when you ask you do not receive because you use the wrong passcode," (James 4:2-3).

Although Christians know the passcode that releases the treasures of heaven, too many fail to properly use it. Like Jesus disciples, you and I need to learn how to pray effectively. - (Matthew 6:5). Jesus said, 1. Praver "When you pray" Prayer is what believers do. a. You should pray (Psalm 5:3; 55: 17; 88: 1-3; I Thess. 5:17). b. You should make prayer apart of your day all day. "Pray without and persistently. Follow the "PUSH" principles: Pray until happens! Pray while you are reading and meditating on the scripture. Use God's word to pray back to Him His promises, (I Jn. 5:16-17). 2. Pray "Go into your prayer closest and shut the door," (Matthew 6: 6-7).
